

- 2. O God, *bring us* back; \* let your face shine on us, and we shall *be* saved.


3. How long, O LORD, *God of* **hosts**, \* will you be angry at the prayer of *your* **people**?

You forgave the guilt of *your* **peo**ple, \* and covered all *their* **sins**.


You averted all *your* rage; \* you turned back the heat of *your* anger.

  - Justice will march *before* him, \* and guide his steps on *the* way.


