

May he send from heaven and save me, † and put to shame those *who assail* me. * May God send his loving mercy *and* faithfulness.


3. My soul lies down *among* lions, * who would devour the sons *of* men.

Psalm 30 (29)


1. O LORD, you have lifted up my soul from *the* **grave**, * restored me to life from those who sink in*to the* **pit**.
