
EASTER SUNDAY

Behind and before, you besiege me, * your hand ever *laid u*pon me.


Too wonderful for me, this **knowl**edge; * too high, beyond my reach.

- 2. Resplendent are you, *more majest*ic * than the everlast*ing* **mount**ains.


The stouthearted, despoiled, *slept in* **death**; * none of the soldiers could lift *a* **hand**.
