

Psalm 27 (26)


- The LORD is my light and my salvation; * whom shall I fear?

Sing praise to our king; sing praise!


4. God is king of *all the* **earth**. * Sing praise with all *your* **skill**.


1. God goes up with *shouts of* joy. *
