

Psalm 33 (32)


- 1. Ring out your joy to the LORD, O *you* **just**; * for praise is fitting for *the* **up**right.

Many are those who attack me, * enemies with lies.


What I have *never* **stolen**, * how can *I restore*?

My mercy and my faithfulness *shall be* with him; * by my name his might shall be *exalted*.


I will keep my faithful love *for him* **al**ways; * with him my covenant *shall* **last**.

COMMUNION (Option 2)




