

1. O LORD, hear a cause *that is* **just**; * pay heed to *my* **cry**.


Turn your ear *to my* **prayer**: * no deceit is on *my* **lips**.

like one roaming among *the* **dead**, * like the slain lying in *their* **graves**,


like those you remember *no* **more**, * cut off, as they are, from *your* hand.

My soul hopes in *the* LORD * more than watchmen *for* daybreak.


3. More than watchmen *for* daybreak, * let Israel hope for *the* LORD.


For with the LORD there *is* **mer**cy, * in him is plentiful *re***demp**tion.



My soul hopes *in the* LORD * more than watch*men for* daybreak.


4. More than watch*men for* daybreak, * let Israel hope *for the* LORD.


Psalm 34 (33)

Psalm 31 (30)


1. Let your face shine on *your* **ser**vant. * Save me in your mer*ciful* **love**.

3. Bring back our ex*iles, O* LORD, * as streams in *the* south.


Those who are sow*ing in tears* * will sing when *they* **reap**.

COMMUNION (Option 2)



Psalm 37 (36)

1. Do not fret because *of the* **wick**ed; * do not envy those *who do* **evil**.

Trust in the LORD *and do* **good**; * then you will dwell in the land and *safely* **pas**ture.

Better the few possessions *of the* **just**, * than the abundant wealth *of the* **wick**ed.

- 2. The LORD takes note of the days *of the* **blame**less; * their heritage will *last for*ever.
 - They shall not be put to shame in *evil* days; * in time of famine they shall *have their* fill.
 - By the LORD are the *steps made* **firm** * of one in whose path *He delights*.
- Then turn away from evil and do good, * and you may abide forever;
 - for indeed, the *LORD loves* **justice**, * and will never for *sake his* **faithf**ul.
- 4. The unjust shall be wiped *out for* ever, * and the descendants of the wick*ed destroyed*.
 - The just shall inher*it the* land; * there they shall a*bide fore*ver.
 - Then wait for the LORD, keep *to his* way. *
 He will exalt you to inher*it the* land.

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
