


Seventh Week in Ordinary Time


ENTRANCE ANTIPHON. *Domine, in tua misericordia speravi.*

VERSES *Usquequo, Domine. Ps 12 : 1*




How long, O Lord ? Will you for-get me for ev-er ? * How long will you hide your face from me ? *Or : me ? Ant.*




H Earken to the voice of my prayer, * O my King and my God, for to you will I pray, O Lord.
