





- 4. Blessed are you on the throne of your **king**dom, \* praiseworthy and exalted above *all forever*. *Ant*.
- 5. *Blessed are* | you who look into the depths / from your throne upon the **cher**ubim, \* praiseworthy and exalted above *all fore*ver.
- 6. Blessed are you in the firmament of **heav**en, \* praiseworthy and glo*rious fore*ver. *Ant*.
