


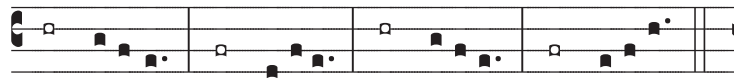



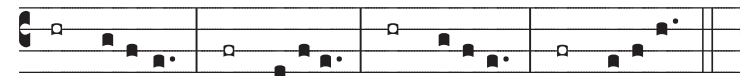

The celebrant (or the cantor) intones three times, each time on a higher pitch, and all repeat :


